- Assessment: Evaluation will be based on class work assignments and unit test. Half yearly and annual examination will also be conducted. Promotion will be based on the overall performance in test and examinations.

Infrastructure & Facilities

To build the right ethos for all round development, the right environment, ambience are of utmost importance. Keeping this in view careful planning has been done for building a state-of-the-art infrastructure and the range of facilities covering each and every aspect of students' need in mind. The school building area covers sixty thousand sq. ft. to cater for the existing and future needs of the student. The spacious school building is surrounded by lush green play field providing an eco friendly, pollution free and quality intensive environment away from the hustle and bustle of the busy city life.



- **Classrooms** : Airy spacious class rooms with adequate natural light and feel of openness.
- **Library** : A well equipped and spacious library to meet the general and specific needs of the students. Well stocked with the vast collection of books to suit the most varied interests.
- **Computer lab** : Fully equipped computer lab with the latest books, CD ROMs and other learning material for interactive learning and well stocked computer library.
- **Science lab** : Spacious Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Maths lab according to CBSE requirements for secondary and senior secondary classes.
- Multimedia mini theatre for conducting spoken English classes and use of audio visual aids for teaching and learning.
- **Play-way equipments** : Modern life size play way equipments for playgroup and nursery classes.
- **Music and Dance classes** : Fully equipped with all the art, craft, music and dance facilities both Western and Indian to develop an appreciation of various art forms as well as the rich cultural heritage.
- **Games and Sports** : An outdoor Stadium for field games and athletic tracks with all facilities for track and field events is under construction. Separate courts for volleyball and basketball as well as facilities for indoor games are available.
- **Healthcare** : The school provides medical assistance to its students within the services of doctors as well as specialist on call as and when required. Medical checkups are conducted regularly and health care of each student is maintained.



Activities

Rules & Regulations

- Registration for admission will be open for boys and girls as per the procedure laid down.
- Registration form can be obtained from the school office along with the prospectus. The registration form must be submitted after being completed in all respects by the date laid down for this purpose along with the registration fees.
- Children must fulfill the minimum age requirement laid down by the school by 1st April.

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| • For Play-group and Nursery | - | 2½ to 3½ yrs. |
| • For KG-I | - | 3½ to 4½ yrs. |
| • For KG-II | - | 4½ to 5½ yrs. |
| • For Class-I | - | 6 yrs and so on. |

- For this the date of birth certificate from the clinic or hospital where the child was born or from the municipal records must be submitted.
- A student who is seeking admission to the school is registered only after the completed registration form is submitted to the school.
- Based on the admission test and other criteria, the school reserves the right to admit students who are found fit for admission. In all matters related to admission the management's decision is final.
- Pupils who have attended other school cannot be admitted until a transfer certificate from the other school duly countersigned by the competent educational authority is produced.
- Full payment of all the fees and dues are payable by a new student at the time of admission, as per the schedule of fees laid down by the school.
- All payments to the school will be made either in cash or by a pay order (local) or a bank draft in the name of the school.

Late Fees

If fees are not paid in full by the specified date, there will be a fine of Rs. 5/- per day.

In case the dues are not cleared, the student may not be allowed to appear for the test / exams or the results may be withheld.

If all the dues are not fully paid by the end of the term, the name of the student will be struck off the rolls and the parents will have to seek re-admission.

Withdrawal

A prior notice of at least 30 days must be given for the withdrawal of a student from the School otherwise the fees for that period will become payable.

Withdrawal notice must be given by the parents only.

No refund will be claimed for the tuition fees paid for the quarter, even if the student leaves before the end of it.

If all dues are not cleared as required by the school, it will not issue transfer certificate, report card and other documents.

Re-admission

If a student's name is struck off the rolls for any reason, he will have to apply for re-admission. If it is permitted by the school, parents will have to pay all the dues, including admission fees etc. as for a new admission.

Decision of the school in all these matters will be final and binding on all parents.

Our expectation from Parents and Guardians

Nalanda Public School, Jabalpur has certain lofty goals, which can be achieved only through the whole hearted support and co-operation of the parents. In order to provide equal opportunities to the students for their physical, mental, moral and ethical development certain rules and regulations have been incorporated in the school diary.
